
Hallmarks of Option 3

- Rapid, efficient enrollment and review process
- Closely monitored and compassionate navigation with a IDOH nurse
- No premiums
- Higher income threshold than other Indiana Medicaid programs
- reconstruction, vision and dental coverage Traditional Medicaid that includes





ELIGIBILITY

- 18-64 year old female for Option 3
- Indiana resident
- US citizen, or legal resident for over 5 years
- receiving treatment Diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer; entering or actively
- Under 200% of the Federal Poverty Level



Process

- *Patient or Provider contacts Option 3 Coordinator.
- *Coordinator speaks with patient or authorized representative
- *Application packet is sent, along with instructions, to patient or provider
- and pathology to Coordinator. Reviewed and forwarded to FSSA. *Application completed and submitted with required ID forms
- eligibility determination. If approved, a RID number is issued. *FSSA staff processes application, conducts interview, and makes



Indiana Breast and Cervical Cancer Program Option 3 Treatment Program Eligibility

The Indiana Breast and Cervical Cancer Program allows women who have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer to apply for Indiana Medicaid. This program provides full healthcare coverage for eligible women through the conclusion of breast or cervical cancer treatment.

Patient must be:

- Indiana resident and US citizen or legal resident (green card) holder for 5+ years
- Uninsured or underinsured (cancer treatment not covered)
- Not enrolled in Medicare
- 18-64 years old
- At or below 200% Federal Poverty Level
